



Denoto is a realtime browser used to preview testimony as it is being given. It may be used by an attorney, judge, paralegal, or a physically challenged person to view and maintain a record of a proceeding.

Unlike other browsers, Denoto is fully integrated with the court reporter's computer-aided transcription software, which will enable the court reporter to *refresh* the testimony. This feature improves the accuracy and completeness of realtime transcripts.

Denoto offers the physically challenged an opportunity to have "equal access" to the record. A judge may use Denoto to review any portion of a realtime testimony or a portion of other records to rule on objections.

An attorney may use Denoto to view the testimony in realtime mode, or use Denoto's case management functions to research and review earlier testimony. The instant review feature may prove to be instrumental in identifying discrepancies in testimony, and it empowers the attorney to impeach a witness.

The advanced realtime features of Denoto allow the user to place private bookmarks and issue codes in their copy of the transcript. The user may also embed a note at any chosen point within the transcript. Denoto enables the user to produce a summary report of a transcript or group of transcripts in a case.

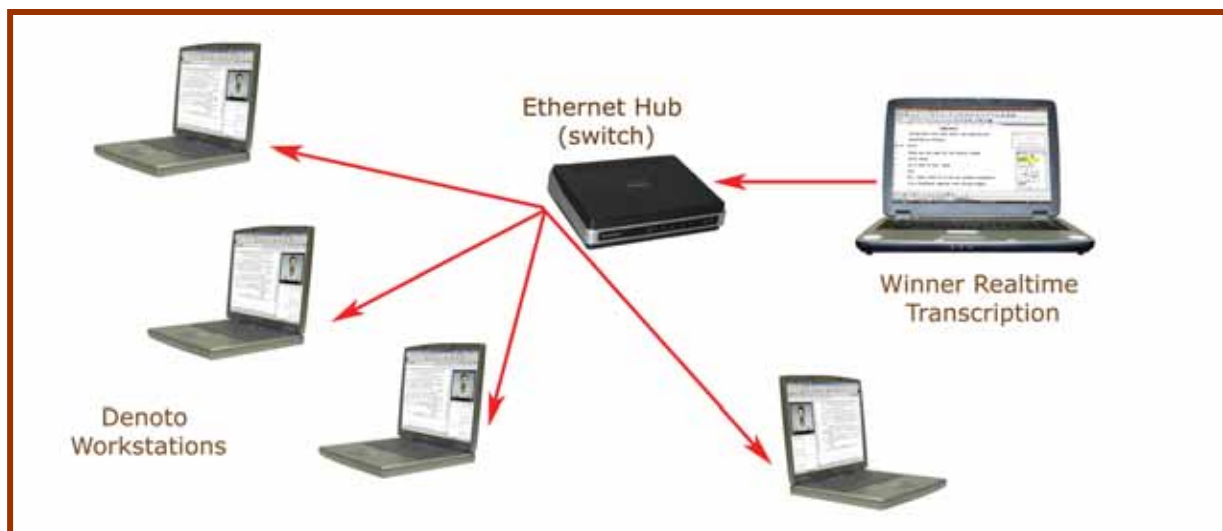

## Wireless (Wi-Fi) Denoto Configuration



Above configuration uses an off-the-shelf wireless router to deliver realtime testimony to the Denoto workstations. The Denoto workstations may be located anywhere within the reach of the wireless router. If the router has a connection to the Internet, remote Denoto users may view the realtime as well. The user may also provide the Refresh service with the above configuration.

## Ethernet Network (LAN) Connection



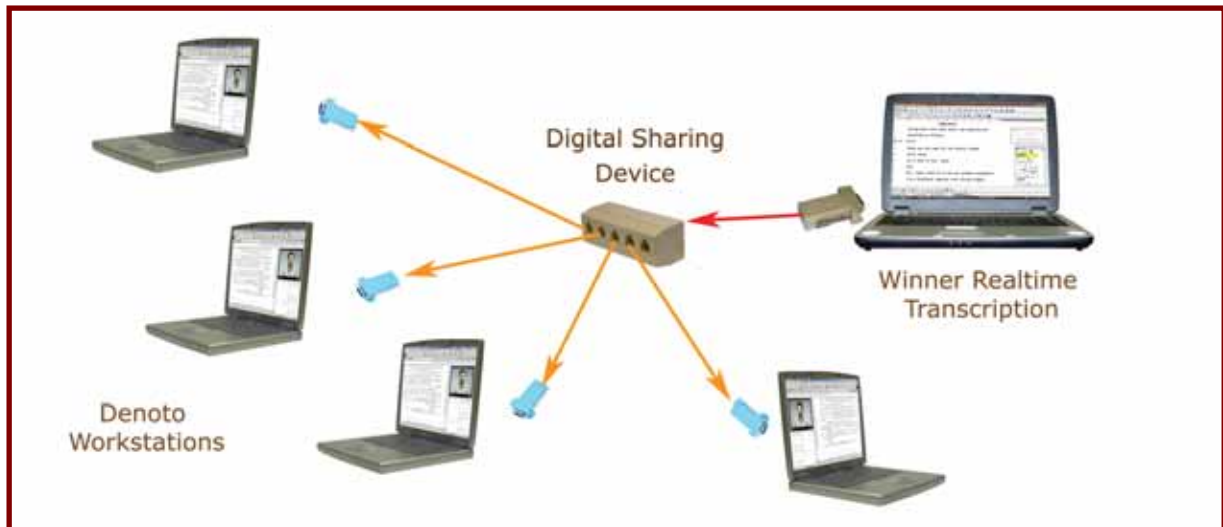
This configuration is principally the same as the Wi-Fi configuration described above. However, this configuration uses Ethernet cables and an Ethernet switch/hub to distribute the realtime testimony. Refresh feature is also available for this configuration.

## Bluetooth (wireless serial) Connection



This configuration eliminates the need for a CAT system. Stylus offers the most comprehensive realtime translation features including an interface to three attorney (Judge) workstations. This configuration uses the Bluetooth (wireless) adapters built into the Stylus and workstations to establish wireless communications. Denoto may be used with an Ethernet or serial mode. Above configuration depicts a wireless serial communications network.

## Serial Connection



You may use serial cables and a sharing device to deliver realtime testimony to Denoto workstations. This configuration requires a serial port on the CAT computer and workstations. Use a realtime cable to connect each computer on the serial network to the Digital Sharing Device.
